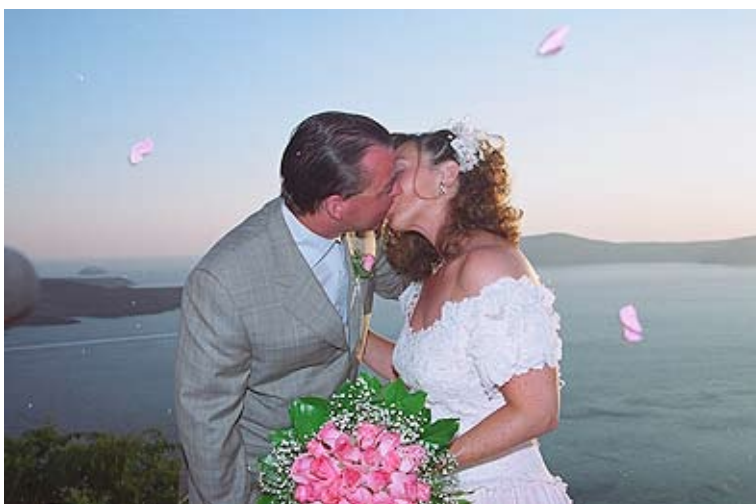

- o Bride's and Groom's birth certificates
- o Final Divorce Decree (if applicable to your case)
- o Legal documentation of name change (if applicable to your case)
- o Wedding license, issued from your country and a Certificate of Single Status and No Impediment to Marry (depending on your origin, please contact the hotel to provide you with more information on the exact Document required)
- o Legal translations of the above Documents in Greek (except from the passports). If your country is a member of the European Union, an International Birth & Wedding certificate can be obtained. In this case no further translation is required.

- o An Apostil Stamp is required for all the Documents (except from the passports) in order to legalize your wedding abroad. This is valid for all countries that have signed the Convention of Hague, October 5th 1961.

Wedding Instructions

Please, fax us the photocopies of the above documentation, no later than 30 days of your wedding date and hand out the originals to the Hotel, upon your arrival.

Conditions

- o The couples that are getting married must be staying at Phenix Hotel.
- o The Wedding ceremony must be performed within the premises of Phenix Hotel.
- o The Bride and the Groom are advised to be on the island a minimum of 48 hours, before the performance of the ceremony.
- o The Wedding dates and times are subject to availability.
- o Any cancellations received within 21 days of the scheduled wedding date are subject to 50% cancellation fees.
- o The ceremony will take place in an outdoor decorated area, created exclusively for the occasion. Our hotel carries no responsibility for any unexpected weather conditions. Nevertheless, we will do our best to change the date and/or time to the next available or perform the ceremony in an indoor area, if possible.

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. "How do we begin the process of arranging our wedding?"**
 - a. Fill in the Wedding Application Form, in order to check for availability and to book your wedding day, the soonest possible.
 - b. Your wedding coordinator will contact you, so that you can start planning together your "perfect day".
 - c. Start preparing all the required paperwork.
- 2. "How can we obtain a Greek Marriage License?"**

It's so easy! As soon as you collect all the necessary documents (at least 30 days prior to your wedding), you will fax them to us so that we can obtain on your account the Greek Wedding License. Please, do not forget to bring along all the original documents.
- 3. "Who performs the ceremony?"**

The Register of Marriages, from the Town Hall, performs the ceremony.
- 4. "Which is the best time of the year to get married in Phenix Hotel"**

We hold weddings from April through October of each year. There is not really one month that is preferred to another. Any month can be the perfect time for you.
- 5. "What happens if it rains on our wedding day?"**

The ceremony takes place in an outdoor decorated area, created exclusively for the occasion. In case of any unexpected weather conditions we will do our best to move



your wedding to another day or another time, during the same day, or perform the ceremony in an indoor area, if possible.

6. **“Do we have to input for our photos or does the photographer set the spots?”**
Our photographer will tell the story of your wedding through the photos: ceremony, exchange of rings, signing the license, champagne opening, cutting of the cake, etc. Following the ceremony, he will make you a tour around the Hotel's area where he will take more pictures of you and of your guests (should you have any). Should you have any special poses you would prefer, simply tell the photographer. He will work with you to make you feel comfortable in order to ensure the best possible memories for your photo album!
7. **“How soon after our wedding shall we get our photos and DVD?”**
Your photos will be delivered to you the following day of your wedding. DVD, will take 2 - 3 days of processing and can be mailed to your home address, without any additional cost.
8. **“Is there any additional paperwork required in order to obtain the Wedding Certificate?”**
In order to obtain the wedding certificate (always issued in Greek), it is necessary to visit the Town Hall in order to sign the Book of Marriages any day after your wedding. In case of weekend or public holiday, a deed authorization to your wedding coordinator is required in order to sign the Book of Marriages on your behalf. The certificate is prepared after 3 weeks and it is mailed to your home address by the Registrar.
9. **“Can we write our own Wedding Vows?”**
Absolutely!! Please, take a look at our vows and feel free to change them or create your own ones that better meet your own feelings for each other.
10. **“Taped music is included. Can we bring our own music?”**
Please, feel free to select the music and the songs you would prefer to hear during the ceremony. You can either bring them with you in a tape or a CD.
11. **“What does the Flower Decoration in the Standard and Superior Wedding package includes?”**
The Flower Decoration includes a beautiful synthesis of flowers, placed on the table, plus two more flower posts, on each side of the Gazebo. The flowers are a combination of roses, lilies, baby's breath and foliage, in a variety of colours of your choice.



12. “What is the “proper” or “accepted” attire for a wedding?”

There’s no such term as “proper” or “accepted” attire! Santorini is famous for its casual-elegance. You are free to be as casual or as formal as you like. Most couples wear clothes as if they are going out for dinner. The Groom may choose to wear slacks with open or banded-collared shirt with or without a jacket, whereas the Bride can wear a nice and attiring - coloured dress. Our suggestion is to think ahead to the days when you’ll remember your wedding through your photos and get dressed the respective way.

13. “How many days do you recommend us to stay in Santorini?”

We suggest a minimum of 5 days, although a week is preferred to allow time to see the sights and relax before and after the wedding ceremony, as Newlyweds on your honeymoon!

14. “How soon, after arriving in Santorini, shall we get married?”

The Bride and the Groom are advised to be on the island a minimum of 48 hours before the ceremony is performed. This will give you enough time to meet your coordinator and arrange all the last minute details before your wedding.

15. “What are your Deposit and Cancellation Policies?”

A deposit of 50% of your wedding total is due upon confirmation. The remaining balance is due at least one week prior to your arrival. A 50% cancellation fee will be applied to the wedding package, if cancelled within 21 days of the scheduled wedding date.

16. Our Tip for your wedding.

Remember to have fun! You have planned this day from the moment you said, “Yes!” Your Wedding day is your moments in the spotlight, so enjoy it.
